Meal Planning on a Budget

What's for dinner? If you're like me, often the answer is "good question!" I go to the grocery store about every other day because there is always something I've forgotten. Maybe meal planning would help me along the way. As I investigate this article, I'm hoping to learn some tips and share them with you. Let's explore this together!

Meal planning should save you money and help create healthier meals. The steps

to meal planning are: Review and set your goals; Create a budget; Select recipes; Complete a meal plan; Make a shopping list; and Store produce.

Review and set your goals: get out your calendar, mark the days you will be eating at home and total up the number of servings you will need to make. (Well that was easier than I was expecting!)

Create your budget: include not only meals, but beverages and snacks, and cost of eating out. Use up what is in your pantry and freezer first. Consider 1 or 2 vegetarian meals a week, beans and lentils are less expensive, yet full of nutrition. Try to shop only once a week, with a list, and keep seasonal and local produce in mind as a better buy. Take the amount of cash you've budgeted and stick to it! And don't forget your coupons.

Select your recipes: here are some websites to try: <u>www.pinterest.com</u>, <u>www.yummly.com</u>, <u>www.foodily.com</u>, <u>www.weelicious.com</u>, <u>www.cabarrushealth.org/299/cookingclasses</u>, <u>www.whatscooking.fns.usda.gov</u>. Try to find healthier recipes that call for produce in season and less use of processed foods.

Complete the meal plan: fill in the calendar with the recipes you've selected, make your shopping list and go shopping. Remember to think about making double and freezing for a busy night. Also, when you shop, stick to the perimeter of the store as much as possible, buy items with the least amount of ingredients and read food labels to find the healthiest option.

Store your produce: fresh produce lasts 3 days to 2 weeks, plan your meals accordingly. Go to <u>http://www.clark.com/29-ways-keep-your-fresh-produce-fresher-longer</u>
