Love - Grow - Serve

By now you have heard me say again and again how excited I am about ministry at Forest Hill. The last few weeks have been fun as we have celebrated our budget overage by blessing missions in Concord and throughout the world. The Finance Committee discussed the spiritual growth of the congregation with our Tithing Challenge last year, and recommended that we challenge God's people again this year to tithe or give beyond a tithe from Lent to Pentecost.

Tithing is a Biblical principle that requires us to trust God, reminds us that all our resources and blessings come from God, and gives God honor and glory. Tithing literally means 10%. The Bible is specific that a tithe is what God desires as a part of our worship. Tithing moves us beyond taking care of ourselves or our church to caring for others as a response to God's good gifts in our lives.

I believe at least two things happen to us as a direct result of our tithing. When we tithe, God pulls and stretches our faith and we grow in response. I got a front row seat to that journey with many of the individuals and families who participated in the Tithing Challenge last year. They shared will me the ways in which they were challenged and grew through their journey to be more faithful. For me, this spiritual growth lines up perfectly with Lent. In Lent, we sit, wait and ask God to help us grow in our faith. The second thing that I believe happens when we tithe is that God blesses us. God wants us to be faithful with God's resources. When we show that we are faithful and follow God's commandments, God gives us more resources to use to God's glory. I know that I have experienced that in my life and in the life of the churches I have served that have taken tithing seriously. I believe last year was a perfect example of this. We made a commitment to God to give over the budget to bless others. We had a plan and together we achieved it. The staff and leadership of the church worked hard to be good stewards of our resources and to stay within budget, so we could fulfill our promise. God saw our commitment and opened our hearts to achieve the goal together.

Far and above any of the things that happen when we tithe is the realization that when we love God, we faithfully follow God's commands in our lives. God asks his faithful followers to give 10% of the 100% that God gives us. As we approach Lent, I encourage to you accept the challenge to test God by giving a tithe or beyond a tithe to FHUMC. On the first Sunday of Lent, March 5, we will begin this journey together. I am committed to giving beyond my tithe to Forest Hill and I invite you to join me as we grow together. God will be glorified, you will be blessed, and FHUMC will be a blessing to people in Concord and beyond. Together we will be faithful in all things!



February is Heart Month!

It's time to think about taking care of your heart! We all need to eat right, exercise, drink plenty of water, and get a good night's sleep. Blah blah blah! We all know all these things! What about your spiritual heart, how can we take care of that? After all, isn't that more important? Yes, the *body* is a temple and we need to physically take care of our hearts, but the body is a *temple* and we need to spiritually take care of our hearts! Jesus told us that the two greatest commandments are to "Love the Lord your God"

with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it, 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'" Take a minute to consider loving your neighbor as yourself. To truly love is take that extra step, like the Good Samaritan did – don't take the easy way out when you love. Loving this way is hard, but stretches and strengthens your heart. When you do love and give, your heart must be prepared. Consider what you are holding in your heart.

Jesus teaches us that we must forgive: "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." I don't know about you, but that scares me a little, actually a lot! Here's how I boil that one down: our hearts are not made to hold anger, bitterness, resentment, grudges, hatred, and unforgiveness. It makes us weak, it separates us from God. Holding all that in your heart hurts no one but yourself. Jesus tells us in Matthew 5:22 that anyone who holds anger **against his brother** will be subject to judgement, and in verse 23 he says that if you are offering your gift at the altar and remember that your brother has something **against you**, you should go first and reconcile, then offer your gift to God. Sounds easy enough, but let's look at the back story. Jesus was talking to a crowd near Capernaum, a 2 to 3 day walk from Jerusalem, where the temple was, where you gave your offering. He said, leave your offering, walk home 3 days, make things right, then walk back 3 days and give your offering. What???? Forgiveness and asking for forgiveness is *that* important! We can't be right with God without forgiveness, not just from God, but from others, and toward others.

One more scary verse from 1 John 4:20-21: "If anyone says, 'I love God,' yet hates his brother, he is a liar. For anyone who DOES NOT LOVE his brother, whom he has seen, cannot love God, whom he has not seen. And He has given us this command: Whoever loves God must also love his brother." We live in an evil, scary world. The *only* thing that makes it good is *God's love*, and us sharing God's love. Loving the way Jesus loves is how to keep your heart healthy! Take care of your precious gift from God, your heart! Love, forgive, and have a strong heart to serve your God.


