Dear Forest Hill Friends,

Spring has sprung at Forest Hill UMC and I am especially excited about two spring events that are happening in April. The first is a spring mission project that is part of a bigger effort throughout Cabarrus County. Cooperative Christian Ministry (CCM) is pulling together churches throughout our area to organize and "love our city" with the love of Jesus Christ throughout the weekend of April 22-24. There is a Concord kickoff worship event on Thursday evening, April 21, 7 p.m. at Connect Church. Forest Hill is sponsoring the snacks for that evening. Churches will be participating in projects throughout the weekend.



At Forest Hill, we are going to "love our city" on Sunday, April 24th. We are hoping to share with some of our first responders (firefighters and EMT's) our love with cookies, milk, notes and prayers. We will begin with lunch together at noon. After lunch we will work together to put our cookies into packages, write notes, make cards, and create prayers to put with the packages. Then we will divide up into teams to take the packages out to the fire stations. Once there, we will deliver the goodies and pray with the men and women who are on duty at the time and ask them to share with those on other shifts. It is a simple project and yet it will take some initiative and courage for us to go to unfamiliar places to deliver the love of Jesus.

There are lots of ways you can get involved. Make cookies at home to bring for the packages. If you attend the 9:00 worship service, help prepare lunch during the 11:00 worship service so we can all eat together. Volunteer to be a team leader who will lead a team to a particular fire station and initiate the prayer for those serving there (we will have a printed prayer for you to pray if you wish). Make cards and notes and help put the goodie packages together. Go with a team to shower our first responders with Christ's love. Pray for this mission project!

We hope you too will get excited about this project! We need at least 100 people signed up to make this project a super success!! Sign up in the narthex or Ministry Center.

The second project I am super excited about is our Community Garden with its launch at the Spring Fling on April 10th. For a few years now, I have dreamed that we might have a community garden at Forest Hill. I could just picture children, youth, and adults of all ages literally getting their hands dirty in the earth to help God make some good nutritious food grow. I am not much of a gardener (though it is in my blood - my grandfather used to have prize-winning gardens in Tampa). I believe in community, I can learn together and alongside some of you to bring forth our crop. Laura Tolbert, our Faith Community Nurse, and I decided we would start off small and see what God has in mind for our garden. On April 10, we will gather at 4:00 to bless and plant our garden, to share in fellowship and games, to share a meal and worship together and then to spread out into age-level groups to study together. The adults will begin a mini study on care of God's creation. I hope to see you at Spring Fling and at our mini-study this spring (April 10, 17, and May 1st).
