Second Blessings Clothing Closet

The Clothing Closet serves families in Cabarrus County by providing donated clean clothing and household items. Giving to Clothing Closet will help provide disposable items such as diapers, formula, wipes, socks, and underwear.

\$ _____ Latino Clinic

One Sunday each month, Forest Hill hosts a preventative care clinic for those in our community. Shot clinics, breast cancer screenings, diabetes screenings, vaccination clinics, bike safety/repair, and much more.

\$ _____ Tuesday Dinner at Kerr Street

Each Tuesday, we serve a free meal to our community. This ministry has a long standing tradition at Kerr Street and offers a place of welcome to our community.

\$_____ Positive Provisions

Through Positive Provisions, we feed public school children on weekends and school breaks who experience food insecurity. Keeping children fed helps them with concentration and improves learning. We are currently feeding 100+ students each week.

\$_____ Forest Hill Youth Ministry

Youth Group is the place where our students grow in their faith and experience fellowship. Your contribution reduces the out-of-pocket cost for events, retreats, mission opportunities, and trips.

\$_____ Good Samaritan Fund

The Good Samaritan Fund is used by our clergy to help people in need pay bills, buy gas, stay in housing, cover the cost of medication and utilities.

\$_____ Global Missions Fund

This fund allows us to expand the missions of the church beyond our local community. Past examples of this include Stop Hunger Now, Operation Hope (providing clean water to communities in Africa) and Project Agape Christmas box supplies.

\$_____ Forest Hill Bilingual Preschool

Forest Hill Bilingual Preschool seeks to be a safe place for preschool-age children to learn and grow in an environment rooted in God's love affirming diversity of language, culture, and economic backgrounds.

Local, Regional, and Global Missions

\$_____ United Methodist Women's Legacy Fund

This endowment of the UMW provides the assurance that United Methodist Women can provide the life-affirming, compassionate care and support that heals, restores and empowers populations of women, children and youth in the years and decades to come.

\$_____ Cooperative Christian Ministries

CCM provides immediate assistance to members of our community who are experiencing crisis in the areas of food, shelter, or finances while engaging them in a series of actions that will empower them to move beyond crisis.

\$_____ Opportunity House

Opp House provides resources to meet the physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual needs of the homeless and disadvantaged and collaborates with community constituents to develop and implement practical solutions that address the root causes of homelessness.

\$_____ UMCOR (United Methodist Committee on Relief)

UMCOR provides humanitarian relief to people in more than 80 countries including the US, when war, conflict, or natural disaster disrupts life. UMCOR spends 100 percent of designated donations on the projects themselves.

\$ _____ Project Agape

Project Agape is a ministry of the UMC to the people of Armenia. It supports a children's home, hospital, clinic, and after-school program. Giving to this ministry also supports the Christmas shoebox ministry.

\$_____ Reconciling Ministries Network

Reconciling Ministries Network (RMN) equips and mobilizes United Methodists to resist evil, injustice, and oppression as they seek justice for people of all sexual orientations and gender identities.
